Those eligible to apply must graduate from high school no later than the year in which they apply. Preference is given (a) to residents of Oakland and Macomb Counties and (b) to college or university upperclassmen. The scholarship recipient will be notified by November 30, 2024. *(NOTE: TGC members and their immediate family members are not eligible to apply for or receive scholarships from the TGC.)*
