46th Annual Garden Walk

Dear Artisan:

We invite you to be part of the Arts & Craft Boutique that will be held in conjunction with the **Troy Garden Club's 2021 Garden Walk on Wednesday, July 14, 2021.**

The Boutique will be held at:

The Troy Historic Village (THV)
60 West Wattles Road
(the northwest corner of Wattles Road (17 Mile Road) & Livernois)

The Boutique runs from 9:00 a.m. until 6:00 p.m. The fee of each space is \$80. However, if your application is postmarked by **May 1, 2021**, you will receive a discounted fee of \$60. All applications must be in by **June 1, 2021.**

Space is available for your own 10' x 10' canopy. If you don't have a canopy, there are also spaces available under covered porches, within the Town Hall and under the shade of the trees at no extra expense. Tables and chairs are not provided.

A garden-walk ticket is not required to visit the Boutique; it is open to the general public. Press releases to that effect will emphasize this and items for sale by our participants will also be listed. To maintain a quality show, manufactured, or 'buy-sell' items are not acceptable. Please submit three (3) photos of your work, only if you are new to the show. Be sure to write your name on the back of the photos. Any photos will be returned on the day of the boutique. There will be garden members available if you need to take a break.

FYI

The Boutique will be open on Tuesday, July 13 from 11:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. to allow artists to set up ahead of time. **The THV property will be locked for the evening.** For those unable to set up Tuesday, the THV will be open by 7:30 a.m., Wednesday morning, July 14.

*****Please note that as we must abide by the Troy Historical Village rules, no one may enter the grounds for set-up before 7:30 a.m.** After set-up, all vehicles must be moved to Lange Street to park inside the back gate. There will also be parking available behind the school of the SE corner of Wattles. Parking is free.

Please do not pack up to leave early. Artists must stay the full time so the evening garden walkers may also have the opportunity to shop at the Boutique.
